

New York Spring and Summer Study 2009: FAQ

Who is eligible to apply?

Summer Study is aimed primarily at undergraduate students as a tool to complement their studies; however anyone over the age of 17 may apply. These courses are open to career changers and anyone with an interest in the subject. Many of our MA students take the Summer Study courses to experience Sotheby's Institute of Art before making the longer commitment to the MA programme.

When is it?

The 2009 Short Courses run in February and March and then again in July and August. The 2009 Summer Study Programmes run from Monday 22 June to Thursday 16 July. Several 'Special' Courses run at other times.

What are the hours?

The hours vary per programme. Please consult the course listing.

Where will the classes be held?

The classes will be held at Sotheby's Institute of Art, 570 Lexington Avenue, NYC, or at Sotheby's Auction House at 1334 York Avenue, NYC.

How much does it cost?

The cost for each 3-week Short Course is \$2,500. The tuition for each 4-week programme course is \$4,000. The tuition for the 'Special' courses varies. Please consult the course listing.

How does the application process work?

Interested students should send the completed application to the address on the form. Once the application is received students should expect to be contacted by Sotheby's Institute of Art within one week.

Are there written assignments and exams?

There is typically a written assignment and one exam for the 4-week courses and the 6-week 'Art Through the Ages' course.

Are the Summer Study courses accredited?

Accreditation is at the discretion of the institution to which the student wishes to transfer the credits. It is advisable to seek approval prior to taking the course.

Do students need to supply a language certificate such as TOEFL?

Students are not required to supply a language certificate but must be aware that the courses are conducted entirely in English and therefore a good knowledge of English is required in order to benefit most from the course.

Do students receive a Certificate of Attendance?

Yes, all students will receive an official Sotheby's Institute of Art Certificate of Attendance. These will be handed out on the last day of the course.
