Pre-College Virtual Program includes:

Live Sessions, online lectures and discussions led by an expert in the field. These sessions focus on content knowledge and may include guest speakers.

Guided activity periods, online activities and projects that will focus on skill development and provide peer-to-peer interaction led either by the lead instructor or the co-instructor, an experienced high school teacher.

Independent study modules will be self-paced, guided assignments that practice skill development and higher-level thinking. These will be available asynchronously on Canvas for students to complete.

Daily meetings and community events will be available to students in all courses to provide opportunities for social engagement. These events will include guest speakers (Master Class, College 101) to supplement the academic experience.

All live sessions and activity periods will be recorded and posted on Canvas for students who cannot participate synchronously.
